

How to Apply for the Erasmus+ Traineeship Program at Vytautas Magnus University

The Erasmus+ Traineeship program at Vytautas Magnus University (VMU) offers PhD students a valuable opportunity to gain international work experience while expanding their academic and professional skills. This program allows students to undertake internships abroad for a duration of 2 to 4 months, with the possibility of extension without a scholarship. The internship has to involve 120 to 160 working hours per month. Based on the internship's success, students may be awarded ECTS credits (40 hours = 1.5 ECTS).

Steps to Participate in the Erasmus+ Traineeship Program

Students who wish to apply for the Erasmus+ Traineeship program must follow these steps:

1. Find a Traineeship Place and Receive a Confirmation Letter
2. Complete the Online Application Form on the VMU Student Portal
3. After the Selection Process, Submit Traineeship Documents, Learning Agreements and Provide Health Insurance

Recognition of the Traineeship

- If the traineeship is part of the student's curriculum, successful completion results in ECTS credits and a grade, with the traineeship details included in the Diploma Supplement.
- For voluntary traineeships, completion is acknowledged in the Diploma Supplement.
